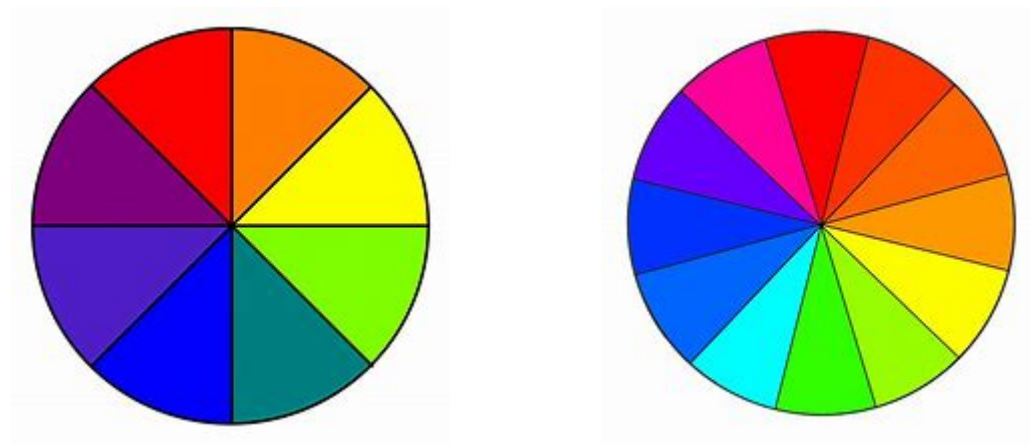

Background information: There are three primary colours: Red, Blue and Yellow. These colours mix to make secondary colours: Orange, Green, Purple.

Artists understand the science of these colours and use a Colour Wheel to organize that information.
